supposedly private letters lady mary was able to find an avenue for her talents that brought her public stature without violating the imperatives of her position as a woman and an aristocrat cynthia lowenthal argues persuasively that lady mary s letters themselves central to the establishment of the familiar letter as an important eighteenthcentury genre were self consciously constructed as literary artifacts and crafted as part of a larger female epistolary tradition moreover lowenthal contends the works of lady mary are essential to the feminist recuperation of women s writing precisely because she provided an aristocratic critique a voice often ignored of the class and gender codes of her day
